Jerry Parr owner of Willow Tree Early Education Team based in Houston, TX, will be presenting at a global forum on early childhood education in Macao, China in April 8 – 11, 2019. Jerry will be joined by over 800 peers from 80 countries to engage in presentations and dialogues on key challenges and opportunities for young children around the world.

Jerry will be sharing his expertise on Men in Early Childhood, another on Stunting (malnutrition), and will participate in the kickoff of the World Forum University. Jerry is also a board member of World Forum, and is a member of the Multi-Site Early Childhood Education Team which works to improve the quality of childcare for large /multi-site organization, and the Men in Early Childhood team which promotes gender balance in Early Childhood staffing.
